Faith in Focus

# Watch out for flying cloaks!

You can't help smiling when you hear, in one of today's readings, how Elijah set his mind on recruiting Elisha. His head-hunting technique would beat any modern employment agency. He just threw his cloak over him! And, strangely, that was enough for Elisha to leave everything (he was ploughing with oxen at the time) and immediately follow Elijah.

In today's gospel we meet several people who feel attracted to Jesus but who want to sort out their various affairs before giving everything up to follow him as disciples. Jesus makes it clear that there can be no "ifs" and "buts" about being a follower of his. Nothing can come between us and God's call, no matter what.

Have you felt the cloak over you? Do you have a keen sense of being called as a Christian or is it no great shakes, like being a member of a club, a football fan or a keen cook?

When Christ demands that we follow him immediately it's not because he's being unreasonable. What's at stake is the urgency of the call. Once perceived, the message of Jesus is not on a par with anything else: it's about the meaning of life and death, about making sense of our present and



taking possession of our future. The call to follow Jesus is the most significant thing that will ever happen to us. All else in life will be measured against how we match up to what Jesus asks of us.

Christians are instinctively restless; like the Son of Man, they have no permanent place to lay their head. They are seized with the import of what has been revealed to them. Its urgency outweighs all other claims on their time. So burying the dead and saying goodbye to people (which Jesus knows we will do anyway) take second place to the demand that we tell others of the good news we have heard ourselves.

Do you feel really called? If the cloak of discipleship has been thrown over you, you'll never want to take it off.
